





WEEK 1 - THE ARRIVAL OF THE KING: MARK 1:1-13

- John the Baptist prepares the way for King Jesus' arrival (vv. 1-8)
- Jesus is royally commissioned for ministry through His baptism (vv. 9-11)
- Jesus immediately goes to battle against Satan in the wilderness (vv. 12-13)

WEEK 2 - JESUS' KINGDOM INVITATION: MARK 1:14-20

- Jesus invites others to be a part of the Kingdom of God through repentance and belief (vv. 14-15)
- Jesus calls his first disciples to sacrificially serve the Servant King (vv. 16-20)

WEEK 3 - JESUS' KINGLY AUTHORITY: MARK 1:21-34

- · Jesus demonstrates his authority through teaching, healing, and exorcisms
- Jesus' Kingly Authority demands a response of worshipful amazement

WEEK 4 - JESUS' KINGDOM PRIORITIES: MARK 1:35-45

- Jesus prioritized prayer, not amassing political power (v. 34)
- Jesus prioritized preaching, not pandering to the crowds (vv. 35-39)
- Jesus prioritized people, not lording a position (vv. 40-45)
