If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him. 27 "Now is my soul troubled. And what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But for this purpose I have come to this hour.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. **Read Matthew 16:18**. How should Jesus' declarative statement that he will build his church and that the gates of hell will not prevail against it encourage you as you look to the future? How does it make you thankful as you look to the past?

2. **Read Philippians 2:5-11**. Meditate on the sacrifices that Jesus made for your benefit and spend time thanking him for what he has done for you. What are some specific ways you can follow this example this week?

3. **Read John 8:29 & 2 Corinthians 5:9**. What are some of the main ways you are tempted to please yourself instead of God? How will you seek to please God in these instances instead of yourself?

4. **Read Philippians 1:29-30**. Imagine what the world would be like if Paul had aimed for a life of comfort and ease instead of embracing the struggles of ministry. If you run away from difficulty for your own comfort, what negative effects will that have in your life and ministry?

5. **Read Philippians 2:14-18**. What are some of the ways you might be tempted to grumble in the sacrifices you make to serve others? How can Paul's example in v.17 encourage sacrifice with gladness instead of grumbling?
