APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- 1. **Read Hebrews 6:9-10**. What difference will the peace that comes from knowing your eternal future is secure in Christ make in your life this week?
- 2. Read Galatians 6:9-10. What are some ways that the peace of eternal security will actually push you forward and motivate growth and endurance in your Christian life?
- 3. Read Psalm 81:11-13. In what ways would you like to see your own heart be less stubborn and quicker to listen to God?
- 4. Spend some time making a list of blessings that are yours because you are in Christ. (Aim for at least 5-10 things on this list). Are these blessings things that you have earned or things that have been given to you because of Jesus? Take time to humbly thank God for these blessings!
- 5. Reread John 6:35-40. Despite the negative response of the crowd, Jesus is still supremely confident in the success of his mission. Have you ever been discouraged in your evangelistic efforts by the negative responses of others? How does the reality that God is working to save sinners encourage you to press on in sharing the gospel?
