- 2. **Read Isaiah 53:3-7** slowly and thoughtfully. In what ways does this dramatic presentation of the sacrifice of Christ spark gratitude in you?
- 3. **Read John 6:63**. What are some ways the feelings of your flesh may be at odds with the word of God this week? Identify some specific Scriptures that will help you listen to the Lord this week in these areas?
- 4. **Read Psalm 16:2-4**. The Psalmist states that being near to God and his people is good, but running after other worldly things doesn't satisfy. How have you seen this to be true in your own life and how does that motivate you to seek the Lord this week?
- 5. How does it comfort you to know that God is not surprised by seeming setbacks in life and ministry?
