## **APPLICATION QUESTIONS**

2. **Read 1 John 5:3**. Are there ways you think of Christ's commandments as burdensome? How can remembering the goodness of Christ's commandments encourage you to obey this week?

3. **Read John 14:16-18**. As you think how you might be used to spread the gospel and glorify God, how should you think differently that God is dwelling in us through the Holy Spirit?

4. **Read Romans 8:26-27**. Especially in light of last week's sermon, how does the fact the Spirit is helping us in prayer encourage you? Why should this promised help make us even more eager and passionate in prayer instead of sloppy or careless?

5. **Read Romans 8:12-16**. We know that the struggle with sin & the flesh can be very real, but what confidence do you gain in your fight against sin knowing that you have the help of the Spirit?
