1. Understand		John 15:1–8 (ESV)
	(vv. 1-8)	15 "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. 2 Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. 3 Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. 4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. 5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide

4. **Read Romans 3:20**. While few people today think they can earn their righteousness by keeping the Old Testament law, what are some ways average people today may rely on themselves and basically come up with their own system of works righteousness?
