APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- 1. **Read Revelation 5:9-12**. How does this heavenly picture, that exalts Jesus for what he has accomplished in salvation, inspire you to worship him now? What from the sermon this weekend helped you grow in your appreciation for your salvation?
- 2. As we navigate the deep truths of God's sovereignty and human responsibility, why do you suppose that some might use God's sovereignty as an excuse for not embracing Christ in faith or as an excuse for not sharing their faith? Have you ever done that?
- 3. **Read Philippians 1:6.** How do verses like this bring a real comfort and joy to your Christian life? Why should verses like this not make us lazy in our Christian life but actually inspire perseverance and growth?
- 4. **Read 1 John 2:15-17 & Romans 12:2**. What are some ways the world will tempt you to follow its pattern this week? How will you renew your mind in God's truth? (Try to be specific here by applying specific truths to the specific temptations you will feel this week.)
- 5. **Read 1 Peter 2:11-12.** How have you seen sin amongst people claiming to be Christians damage efforts to share the gospel? In what ways can you seek to "keep your conduct honorable" so that you may faithfully shine the light of the gospel?
