1.Humbly		Ecclesiastes 6:10-7:6 (ESV)
2. Prepare	(7:1-2)	10 Whatever has come to be has already been named, and it is known what man is, and that he is not able to dispute with one stronger than he. 11 The more words, the more vanity, and what is the advantage to man? 12 For who knows what is good for man while he lives the few days of his vain life, which he passes like a shadow? For who can tell man what will be after him under the sun?  7:1 A good name is better than precious ointment and the day of death than the day of birth.  2 It is better to go to the house of mourning than to go to the house of feasting, for this is the end of all mankind, and the living will lay it to heart.  3 Sorrow is better than laughter, for by sadness of face the heart is made glad.  4 The heart of the wise is in the house of mourning, but the heart of fools is in the house of mirth.  5 It is better for a man to hear the rebuke of the wise than to hear the song of fools.  6 For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so is the laughter of the fools; this also is vanity.

- 4. **Read Psalm 90:12**. How will your life benefit from thinking more about death and how short your life will be? How should that affect your priorities?
- 5. **Read Ecclesiastes 7:5 & Proverbs 27:6**. What are some of the reasons we might avoid a wise rebuke or a wound from a friend? What benefit will you receive if you are more open to listening to counsel from others?
