APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. **Read Psalm 51:3-4.** What are some ways you might be tempted to downplay the seriousness of your own sin? Identify any sins in your own life where you may make excuses for your sin or view it as "not that big of a deal".

2. Identify at least three verses/passages that highlight the forgiving nature of God. How do these passages encourage you to look to God for mercy and to anticipate the joy that comes along with forgiveness?

3. **Read 2 Corinthians 7:10-11.** If you are truly seeking inward change and a renewed spirit, what kind of attitudes and actions should you expect to see in your own life after you have confessed your sins?

4. **Read 2 Corinthians 5:20-21.** Both humility and boldness are required to make the kind of appeal described in this passage. How would you like to see more of each of these qualities in your evangelism?

5. **Read Psalm 51:18-19.** How can the sin of an individual negatively affect a group? How can this thought make a difference in your own pursuit of sanctification?
