## **APPLICATION QUESTIONS**

1. **Reread Psalm 32:1-4**. How have you seen both the pain of guilt and the joy of forgiveness in your own life? How do these realities deepen your appreciation for what God has done for us?

2. Find another passage that expresses the joy of justification and meditate on that passage this week. What about this passage stands out to you about the wonder of God's forgiveness?

3. **Read Proverbs 1:20-33**. What are both the warnings and the promises of this passage? Are there ways you are currently ignoring wisdom and/or your conscience?

4. **Read Isaiah 55:6-9**. What are some of the excuses people make to delay seeking the Lord and his forgiveness? Have you ever made any of those excuses and are there any ways you may be making those excuses now?

5. **Read Titus 2:11-14**. As you think about this upcoming week, what are some ways you need to be trained by the grace of God to say "no" to ungodliness and "yes" to righteousness?
