	(vv. 1-2) 63 A PSALM OF DAVID, WHEN HE WAS IN T WILDERNESS OF JUDAH.
A. Because	1 O God, you are my God; earnestly I see you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is a water. 2 So I have looked upon you in the sanctubeholding your power and glory. 3 Because your steadfast love is better the life, my lips will praise you. 4 So I will bless you as long as I live;
B. Because	in your name I will lift up my hands. 5 My soul will be satisfied as with fat and a food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful li 6 when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night; 7 for you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy. 8 My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.
C. Because	9 But those who seek to destroy my life shall go down into the depths of the earth 10 they shall be given over to the power of the sword; they shall be a portion for jackals. 11 But the king shall rejoice in God; all who swear by him shall exult, for the mouths of liars will be stopped.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- 1. Would you consider yourself a satisfied person? If you have already put your trust in Christ, what do you think is holding you back from finding full satisfaction in Christ alone?
- 2. **Read Psalm 63:1.** Have you ever prayed like this before? If so, how often do you come before the Lord in desperation for the satisfaction only He can provide? If not, spend some time crying out to God for your soul to be refreshed by Him alone!
- 3. **Read Romans 8:38–39.** How can understanding God's loyal love motivate you to seek Him even more?
- 4. **Read Phillippians 4:6-7.** Spend some time listing off things that you are thankful to God for. Don't overthink your list; write down whatever comes to mind. Pray your thanksgiving list for the next week as you seek satisfaction from God, knowing that He will continue to bless you as His child.
- 5. **Read Hebrews 12:1–2.** How can looking back at the life of former faithful saints encourage you to seek the Lord even more for all of your needs? Are there any distractions or sins you need to "throw off" so you can cling to the Lord Jesus without anything holding you back?
